The Hillside Park Phase I Building C project will include design and construction of 100 affordable housing units at the Housing Authority of Clackamas County 16-acre property at 2887 SE Hillside Court, Milwaukie, OR 97222

The residential redevelopment of the Hillside Park public housing complex will be a multiphased, mixed-finance development. The full redevelopment project entails the construction of roughly five hundred (500) units, which includes one hundred (100) replacement units of affordable housing units and market rate housing.
