Approval of an Amendment extending the duration of the negotiation period of the Ambulance Contract with American Medical Response Northwest, Inc. Amendment has no fiscal impact, contract value remains at \$60M over 10 years. Funding through American Medical Response Northwest, Inc. No County General Funds are involved.

Purpose/Outcome	Extend Amendment #3 with American Medical Response, providing an additional six months to implement Ambulance Service Plan update recommendations from Cambridge Consulting Group, LLC.

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BACKGROUND: In December 2021, the BCC signed Amendment #3 to the Ambulance Contract between Clackamas County and American Medical Response Northwest, Inc. This amendment signifies the intent to develop a performance-based ambulance service contract and to negotiate in good faith through January 1, 2023.

Cambridge Consulting Group, LLC recently completed its ambulance service plan update recommendations. There are 21 recommendations to consider.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of this contract extension.

AMENDMENT #4 TO THE AMBULANCE CONTRACT BETWEEN CLACKAMAS COUNTY AND AMERICAN MEDICAL RESPONSE NORTHWEST, INC.

This Amendment #4 is entered into between American Medical Response Northwest, Inc. ("Contractor") and Clackamas County ("County") and shall become part of the Contract documents entered into between both parties on May 1, 2014 ("Contract").

On or about December 17, 2020, Contractor and County executed Amendment #2 to the Contract. Amendment #2 established a framework wherein the parties would negotiate, in good faith, towards a potential amendment that would update the Contract to a performance-based structure. Amendment #2 provided that the obligation to negotiate, in good faith, would terminate on January 1, 2022. The parties desire to continue the ongoing negotiations.

The Purpose of this Amendment #4 is to extend the negotiation period set forth in Amendment #2:

1. <u>Amendment #2, Section 2, Negotiation Term</u>, is hereby amended as follows:

The obligation to negotiate, in good faith, pursuant to the terms of Amendment #2 is hereby extended from January 1, 2022 to **July 1, 2023**. Nothing herein shall be construed as changing the current Contract termination date of May 1, 2024.

Except as expressly amended above, all other terms and conditions of the Contract, including all amendments thereto, shall remain in full force and effect. By signature below, the parties agree to this Amendment #4, effective upon the date of the last signature below.
