

Request for Ballot Title

Preparation or Publication of Notice

No later than the **80th day before an election**, a governing body that has referred a measure must prepare and file with the local elections official the text of the referral for ballot title preparation or the ballot title for publication of notice of receipt of ballot title. This form may be used to file the text of the referral and request the elections official begin the ballot title drafting process or file a ballot title and request the elections official publish notice of receipt of ballot title.

Shall District increase safety; repair and update schools and facilities; improve technology; and issue \$22,900,000 in bonds with citizen oversight? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

District is on the waiting list to receive a matching grant of up to \$4,000,000 from the State of Oregon if bonds are approved. Establishes a citizen bond oversight committee to ensure proceeds are used for indicated purposes. Bonds would mature in not to exceed 16 years from issuance and may be issued in series. The estimated tax rate is \$1.00 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. Actual levy rate may differ due to changes in interest rates and assessed value.
