Planted by Wes Cook in the 1940's

Grove of 12-13 Coast Redwoods & Douglas Fir This stand of trees is dis-

persed along the Kellogg Creek bed and roadway.

Kellogg Creek provides a thriving environment that supports a lush timber canopy and significantly large-sized trees.

The previous owner, Wes Cook, once owned a majority of the property in the neighborhood and ensured that the area remained well-stocked with timber.

The tree stand is likely the result of a planting in the 1940s. The result is a well-screened, peaceful park-like setting.
