Trauma Informed Care	There was a presentation about Trauma Informed Care and what it means and how it can very from person to person. The same experience can effect people differently. We focus more on the response the person has and not just the event. Clackamas County wants to use Trauma informed care to recognize that everyone who picks up a phone or walks through our doors have unique experiences of trauma, so we want to set up services knowing this. This includes items such as focusing on how the lobby is set up, the types of greetings that are used when someone walks through the door, the tone of voice and how we explain things, etc. Adopting a trauma informed plan will always be on the County's agenda. Behavioral Health holds a monthly committee on Trauma Informed Care to discuss improvements that can be made.
