Develops a suite of options for residents of Clackamas County to broaden ways for people to travel, including new and innovative opportunities



Explores strategies to reduce congestion on roadways such as vanpools, commuter shuttles, and reduced-cost transit pass programs




Conceptualizes, develops, and implements a limited **pilot program** to improve mobility in Clackamas County
