## WHAT ACTION ARE YOU REQUESTING FROM THE BOARD?

Staff requests approval of the 2017 Small Grants Recommendation

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The Clackamas County Board of Commissioners approved \$250,000 in the 2017/18 FY budget to fund the 2017 Small Grants Program. This is the ninth year of the program. The goal is to support agencies that are making an effort to develop and implement innovative projects that would help most vulnerable families, seniors, and others meet their basic needs such as food assistance and abuse prevention. Preference is given to those who meet the following criteria:

- Prevent occurrence of larger, more dire problems later;
- Save money later through early intervention;
- Serve people throughout the community.

For the 2017 cycle, Administration staff, along with Public and Government Affairs and Technology Services worked diligently to increase awareness and ease of use of our website and application process. We continued to use the online application which has demonstrated to be an effective and easy way for organizations to turn in their applications.

We received 71 applications for a total request of \$730,830.69. This is an increase in both applications and total amount requested. Last year there were 69 applications which totaled \$711,084.60. A committee was formed to review the applications as well as past small grant awards and current funding from other County departments to determine the attached recommendations (attachment 1). The committee included Caroline Hill, Small Grants Coordinator; Kimberlee DeSantis, Commissioner Policy Advisor; Rachel Pearl, Juvenile Department and Jamie Zentner, Health Housing and Human Services.

Information was distributed to committee members in August for review prior to two subsequent meetings on September 18 and October 4. Our focus was to ensure that the monies were dispersed as evenly as possible throughout the County and to impact diverse groups.

Today we are seeking approval of the recommendation (see attachment 1) from the Board so that we can process awards.
