## **Stand of 21 Trees - Variety of Species**

This stand of twenty-one trees is located within the Molalla farmlands. The stand is part of a larger stand of trees located just south of a natural streambed. During the heavy rain season the land is saturated with water.

A stand of pine trees are the most significant trees on the site. Pine trees are rapidly growing trees and can live to 125 years and grow up to and average of 100-160 feet with an average diameter of 2—4 feet. The more prominent pine trees on the Heublein property are well within the average dimensions. This stand of trees are nominated under the criteria of collection.

The stand of trees is nominated and approved under Heritage Tree category of a collection.
