In order for a building permit to be issued, Sections D through F of this agreement shall be completed, and the agreement shall be signed by the contractor, the engineer of record, and the owner or the owner's authorized agent.

In accordance with 2022 Oregon Structural Specialty Code (OSSC) Sections 107.1, 1704 and 1705, structural observations, a quality assurance plan, and special inspections have been identified in a program statement prepared by the registered design professional in responsible charge for all work that falls within the categories specifically identified in these OSSC Sections. This statement is included within the approved construction documents, and all special inspections, testing, quality assurance, and structural observations will be determined and performed following this statement.

All special inspections and testing shall be performed in accordance with the provisions of OSSC Sections 1704 and 1705. The special inspector shall comply with the duties and responsibilities presented in the Oregon Building Officials Association (OBOA) Special Inspection Program (SIP), and shall observe and document the work for conformance with the approved plans and specifications. (Upon request, copies of the OBOA SIP can be provided for review. In addition, the entire OBOA Special Inspection Program is available for review on their web site at www.oregonBuildingOfficials.com.)

During the project, the County field inspection staff will monitor the special inspections, testing, quality assurance, and structural observations and shall have the ability to question results as needed to maintain compliance with the approved program. All written results of these inspections or tests, including noncompliance lists and final summary letters, shall be provided to the Building Official and the registered design professional in responsible charge.
