	 We saw a 2+ month delay in approving 2 new council members so we couldn't get above our lower limit of 9 which also HRSA commented on but not a finding. Currently we are seeing a several month delay in getting a county commissioner representative assigned which makes it difficult to get CHC issues to the full county board.
Ad Hoc Committee Director Selection	Committee update: Ad Hoc Director Selection Committee Report 04-19-2023
	 The process has been frustrating and difficult to navigate. CHC did have good input for question development and scoring grid. Two-day notice for 1st round interview, created hardship for panel and some were unable to attend or had to miss work. Panel could only participate if available for the entire day meaning some panel members were left out. Round 1 had 3 CHC members and 3 county/health centers staff on the panel. Round 2 had 3 CHC members and 5 county/health centers staff on the panel. Though we were coached on bias, it feels that some were not able to stay clear of this. When this was pointed out, we received denial and push back. Current state is that we have two excellent applicants remaining and hope to complete selection in May.
FQHC Staff Report	SBHC: Oregon Trail School District with not renew contract from 23-24 school year with Clackamas County for Sandy High School. Next month Sarah will present on SBHC and request a vote on the changes of scope.
	New Grants: Sarah reported on five new smaller grant opportunities. Two HRSA Grants: Early childhood development grant(application will be submitted May 1 ^{st:}), and School based site expansion. Three CJC Grants that will assist adult drug court, mental health court, and DUI Court. Grants are not approved yet, but the applications have been submitted for all but the Early childhood development grant.
	BH Move update: Health Centers is exploring new location close to original building.
	New County Court House: 15 million dollars needed to be identified in the budget for the year to fund the court House. Sarah stated that Health Centers does not currently received any general fund from the County.
