STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

1. Prior to the Hearing. You have the right to make the following requests:

- (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and to talk to County staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
- (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
- (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- 2. <u>Procedure</u>. The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence, the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of the
- evidence that a violation exists, or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney to represent them at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question the
- parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- 3. <u>Record of Proceedings</u>. An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- 4. <u>Hearings Officer</u>. The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence, and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a Final Order or Continuing Order. The Hearings Officers Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon law. - 5. <u>Right to Recess</u>. If, during the course of the hearing, Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceeding be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- 6. <u>Right to Appeal</u>. The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

I, Diane Bautista, Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

Respondent's mailing address is: 30740 S. Marian St., Molalla, OR 97038.

The address or location of the violation(s) of law alleged in this Complaint is:

30740 S. Marian St., Molalla, OR 97038, also known as T5S, R3E, Section 05CC, Tax Lot 01500,

and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon.

3.

On or about the 11th day of June, 2024 and on or about the 17th day of September, 2024,

the Respondent violated the following laws, in the following ways:

Respondent violated the Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance, Title
12, by occupying recreational vehicles without land use approval. This violation is a
Priority 2 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

5.

Notice of the violation was given to Respondent in the following manner: Violation notice dated June 11, 2024 and Citation and Complaint #2400206 dated September 23, 2024. A copy of the notice documents are attached to this Complaint as Exhibits C and E, and incorporated by this reference.

6.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter. Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to immediately abate the violation and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining Respondent from violating these laws in the future;

2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty against Respondent for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County Commissioners. Said range for for a Zoning Ordinance Title 12, Priority 2 violation being \$500.00 to \$2,500.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code;

 Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to pay an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A of the Clackamas County Code; 4. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties, fines or fees that may be imposed:

5. Ordering any other relief deemed reasonably necessary to correct the violation.

History of Events and Exhibits:

May 21, 2024	Clackamas County received a complaint regarding homeless camps and solid waste.
May 21, 2024 Exhibit A	Correspondence was sent to the Respondent regarding the potential zoning and solid waste code violations.
June 11, 2024 Exhibit B	2024 I conducted a site inspection and confirmed 3 occupied recreational vehicles, a tent and miscellaneous debris.
June 11, 2024 Exhibit C	Correspondence was sent to the Respondent for the zoning and solid waste code violations with a deadline of July 11, 2024 to abate the violations.
July 16, 2024	I received a voicemail from Michelle Davis who stated that she is the caregiver for the Respondent and has the authority to try and resolve any issues on the property. Julia has been in the hospital and they just saw the violation notice.
July 22, 2024	I returned the call from Michelle Davis and she said the "Sprinter" RV located by the house is occupied by someone who helps take care of the owner. The cream and brown RV near the sprinter is occupied by Tom Smith and he was supposed to be there temporarily. The RV on the other side with blue and pink pin stripe is occupied by a friend of hers. She said the tent was never occupied and has since been sold.
September 17, 2024 Exhibit D	I conducted a site inspection and confirmed the occupied recreational vehicles remained on site.
September 23, 2024 Exhibit E	Citation 2400206 was issued for \$400.00 for the zoning code violation. The citation was mailed via first class mail and was not returned to the County. This citation remains unpaid.
November 26, 2024 Exhibit F	I conducted a site inspection and confirmed the zoning code violations remain.

December 5, 2024 The County referred this matter to the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.

If the Compliance Hearings Officer affirms the County's position by a preponderance of the evidence, the County may request a Final Order in this matter recommending the following:

- The imposition of civil penalties for the Zoning and Development Ordinance violation of up to \$2,500.00 for date cited September 17, 2024.
- Payment of \$400.00 for Citation 2400206 issued on September 23, 2024.
- The administrative compliance fee calculated at \$75.00 per month from July 2024 until the violation is abated. The current amount due is \$375.00.
- The County requests the Hearings Officer to permanently prohibit the Respondent from violating this law in the future.
- If the Respondent fails to comply with the Hearings Officer's Final Order the County requests the Hearings Officer to authorize the County further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.

This letter serves as notice of violations of the Clackamas County Code. The violations include:

- Occupied recreational vehicles
- Occupied tent
- Accumulation of solid waste

VIOLATIONS & HOW TO RESOLVE

Occupied Recreational Vehicles and tent

Occupied recreational vehicles and tents constitute a violation of Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance, Title 12, Section 316.03(A). In order to abate the violations, you must complete one of the following **no later than July 11, 2024:**

- Submit a new and complete application for land use authorization to occupy a recreational vehicle, **or**;
- If the recreational vehicles are operable, currently licensed and registered to the person residing on the subject property, they may remain in stored condition. If you wish to store it on site please provide evidence it meets these conditions and schedule a site inspection to confirm, or;

- Remove the recreational vehicles from your property to an authorized location, and;
- Cease staying in the tent and remove.

Solid Waste

An accumulation of solid waste constitutes a violation of Solid Waste and Waste Management Code, Title 10, Chapters 10.03.060 (A) and (B), as it provides a condition of unsightliness and is considered a public nuisance. In order to abate the violations, you must complete the following **no later than July 11, 2024:**

• Remove or screen all solid waste, including but not limited to equipment and furniture; vehicle parts; tires; scrap metal, or any other useless, unwanted or discarded material, or other similar non-putrescible solid waste or waste that is visible from the road or surrounding properties.

Important Notices

- Administrative Compliance Fees. It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. An administration compliance fee of \$75 will now be assessed monthly until the violations are abated.
- 2. Failure to resolve those violations may result in one or more of the following: (1) a citation and fine, and (2) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement Compliance Hearings Officer.
- Request for a Hearing: If you dispute the existence of the violations described in the enclosed letter you may request a hearing before the Hearings Officer by sending a written request for a hearing, including your name and address to: Code Enforcement Section, 150 Beavercreek Rd., Oregon City, OR 97045, or at codeenforcement@clackamas.us.
- 4. **Potential Fines and Penalties:** The Clackamas County Code provides for Citation fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties imposed by the Hearings Officer of up to \$3,500 for each day the County verifies the noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties may be assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.
- 5. Voluntary Compliance: Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may in its discretion waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.
- 6. Non-Compliance may result in a lien upon your property: Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered, the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Record.
- 7. Final Order may be enforced in Circuit Court: Also, be advised that noncompliance with a Hearings Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel for legal action in Circuit Court which may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.
- 8. **Recurrences will result in additional Citations:** Finally, recurrences of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.
