



Station #1: Feasibility Study Overview

PURPOSE:

- Analyze the feasibility of alternatives for transportation across the Willamette River at the Canby Ferry location
- Study the following factors for each alternative:
 - Costs and financial feasibility
 - Traffic impact
- Develop findings for each alternative to present to the Board of Commissioners

ALTERNATIVES BEING STUDIED:

- Continue operation of the Canby Ferry
- Discontinue operation of the Canby Ferry
- Construct a bridge funded with county transportation funds
- Construct a bridge funded with county transportation funds and continue operation of the Canby Ferry
- Construct a bridge that would be funded through tolls
- Construct a bridge that would be funded through tolls and continue operation of the Canby Ferry

REASON FOR STUDY:

- The Canby Ferry service, which is limited by the size of the ferry and weather conditions, operates at an annual loss of more than \$450,000.

TIMELINE:

- Spring-fall 2018: Analysis of the alternatives
- June 13, 2018: Open house on project purpose and process, and gather public input
- Fall 2018: Open house to present study findings
- Fall-winter 2018: Present findings to Board of County Commissioners

NEXT STEPS:

- Once the findings have been presented to the Board, the Board will have a number of options, including:
 - Accept the report and take no further action
 - Ask for additional information about one or more of the alternatives
 - Accept the report and direct staff to move forward with one of the alternatives

PLEASE NOTE: The study will NOT make any recommendations about the Canby Ferry or any other alternatives.
