Quilt Divisions NEW Rules and Guidelines

1. All quilts are required to have a 4" wide hanging sleeve attached to the top/back of the quilt for display purposes. This will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It can be sewn on or safety pinned on.
2. Every quilt is required to have a Clackamas County Fair Quilt Information Form filled out and turned in with each quilt. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Design: Use of Pattern and Design.....45%
Workmanship.....45%

Specific Rules:

1. Read through all the general rules found on the Clackamas County Fair website.
2. All exhibitors must use a Personal Exhibitor number on all entries. This number can be any (4) four numbers of your choosing.
3. Limit of (1) one entry per class per exhibitor.
4. Exhibits, which are entered in the “wrong division”, will be reclassified at the discretion of the Superintendent.
5. Entries must stay for the length of the fair.
6. Judges will award first, second, third, etc. ribbons according to merit.
7. Please make sure you fill out the description of your entry on the entry form.
8. All Entries Must Be Clean! No pet Hair.
9. All entries must be the handiwork of the exhibitor.
10. It is not necessary to pre-enter entries. Forms are available to fill out when you bring in your entries.
11. All entries completed during the latter part of last year and during this year will be shown preference. Any article more than 5 years old will be barred from showing except with permission of the superintendent.
12. Articles entered for premiums must be completed projects. No article will be eligible for premium if it has received a prize in previous years at the Clackamas County Fair.
13. Items will be disqualified if they have a price tag.
14. Sets must be pinned together or attached by other means to avoid separation.
15. Juniors may not compete in similar classes in both junior and adult classes.
16. All reasonable care will be exercised to safeguard entries. Clackamas County Fair will not be responsible for loss of or damage of any entry.
17. In determining special awards for most points earned, the following applies: blue 5 points, red 3 points, white 1 point. In the case of a tie, the winner with the most Blue ribbons shall be the winner.
18. Champion ribbon awarded in each Division
19. No premium will be awarded just because there is no other competition in the class. If the article is not deemed worthy of a 1st place, it may be awarded a lesser premium.
20. No exhibit deemed unworthy shall be awarded a ribbon or premium.
21. Submission of entry implies exhibitor’s acceptance of the rules.
