EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: This amendment is to establish the new legal name and tax ID of the vendor from Regional Toxicology Services, LLC dba Cordant Health Solutions to Navis Clinical Laboratories, Inc. dba Regional Toxicology Services, LLC and to add funds to the agreement due to increases in lab utilization.

This addition of funds will allow the Health Centers Division Behavioral Health clinic to continue providing the best care to our community. This contract allows our clinicians more time with clients by providing professional collection services. Furthermore, as part of recovery from Substance Use Disorders (“SUD”), most patients’ treatment plans require regular drug testing. Navis Laboratories executes excellent and timely services with a collection site within two miles of our clinic.

TO THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS WITH NAVIS CLINICAL LABORATORIES, INC FOR
HILLTOP CLINIC DRUG TESTING SERVICES
Contract #1936

This Amendment #3 is entered into between **NAVIS CLINICAL LABORATORIES, INC** (“Contractor”) and Clackamas County (“County”) and shall become part of the Contract documents entered into between County and Regional Toxicology Services, LLC on **April 2, 2020** (“Contract”).

The Purpose of this Amendment #3 is to make the following changes to the Contract:

1. Effective January 27, 2023, Contractor has purchased Regional Toxicology Services, LLC. As a result, all rights, responsibilities, and contractual obligations of Regional Toxicology Services, LLC have been assumed by Contractor. A copy of the notice of purchase is attached hereto as Exhibit A to this Amendment #3. By execution of this Amendment #3, Contractor represents and warrants it has fully and unconditionally assumed all the obligations, liabilities, warranties, and responsibilities under the Contract. Contractor shall honor and continue to perform under the Contract, as amended. By execution of this Amendment #3, County hereby consents to the assignment and assumption of the Contract to Contractor.


2. ARTICLE 1. Section 3. **Consideration** is hereby amended as follows:
 County expects it will need Contractor to perform drug testing Work in excess of the current not-to-exceed amount of the Contract as a result of increased drug-testing needs. As such, County authorizes an increase in compensation in the amount of \$150,000. The maximum compensation authorized under this Contract shall not exceed \$650,000.00. Consideration rates are on a fixed fee basis in accordance with the rates and costs of the Contract.
