Total Agreement Value is increased to \$12,433,475.76 for 2 years. Funding is through the Oregon Health Authority and the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. No County General Funds are involved.**

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:** The Clackamas County Public Health Division (CCPHD) of the Health, Housing & Human Services Department requests the approval of Amendment #11 to the Revenue Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Health Authority (OHA) for the financing of Public Health Services.

This housekeeping item is submitted in batches. Funding through this Agreement allows the CCPHD to continue to provide core public health-related services to Clackamas County residents. Amendment #11 adjusts the following Program Elements (PE):

- \$134,893 -16-HIV Prevention Services (PE07)
- \$74,943.00 - Public Health Practice - Immunizations Services (PE43-01)
- \$125,833.33 -Overdose Prevention for the Opioid Program (PE62)

**AMENDMENT TO OREGON HEALTH AUTHORITY  
2023-2025 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE  
FINANCING OF PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES**

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This Eleventh Amendment (this “Amendment”) to Oregon Health Authority 2023-2025 Intergovernmental Agreement for the Financing of Public Health Services, effective July 1, 2023, (as amended, the “Agreement”), is between the State of Oregon acting by and through its Oregon Health Authority (“OHA”) and Clackamas County, (“LPHA”), the entity designated, pursuant to ORS 431.003, as the Local Public Health Authority for Clackamas County. OHA and LPHA are each a “Party” and together the “Parties” to the Agreement.

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, OHA and LPHA wish to modify the Fiscal Year 2025 (FY25) Financial Assistance Award set forth in Exhibit C of the Agreement.

WHEREAS, OHA and LPHA wish to modify the Exhibit J information required by 2 CFR Subtitle B with guidance at 2 CFR Part 200 (FY25);

**AGREEMENT**

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, covenants and agreements contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. This Amendment is effective on **August 1, 2024**, regardless of the date this amendment has been fully executed with signatures by every Party and when required, approved by the Department of Justice. However, payments may not be disbursed until the Amendment is fully executed.
2. The Agreement is hereby amended as follows:
  - a. Exhibit C, Section 1 of the Agreement, entitled “Financial Assistance Award” for FY25 is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety by Attachment A, entitled “Financial Assistance Award (FY25)”, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. Attachment A must be read in conjunction with Section 3 of Exhibit C.
  - b. Exhibit J of the Agreement entitled “Information required by 2 CFR Subtitle B with guidance at 2 CFR Part 200” (FY25) is amended to add to the federal award information datasheet as set forth in Attachment B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
3. LPHA represents and warrants to OHA that the representations and warranties of LPHA set forth in Section 4 of Exhibit F of the Agreement are true and correct on the date hereof with the same effect as if made on the date hereof.
4. Capitalized words and phrases used but not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed thereto in the Agreement.
5. Except as amended hereby, all terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
6. This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, all of which when taken together shall constitute one agreement binding on all parties, notwithstanding that all parties are not signatories to the same counterpart. Each copy of this Amendment so executed shall constitute an original.
