WHAT ACTION ARE YOU REQUESTING FROM THE BOARD?

Approve presentation at a business meeting of the proposed county code amendment for Chapter 6.06, County Parks.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Parks ordinance was reviewed and amended in May 2014. It has come to our attention since that time that failure to display a park entry permit is not currently a violation.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS (current year and ongoing):

No direct financial cost or benefit.

LEGAL/POLICY REQUIREMENTS:

Attached for Board review as <u>Exhibit A</u> are the proposed amendments to the county parks ordinance (Chapter 6.06 of the county code). The change included allows parks employees to cite park users who fail to properly display park entry permits. Currently, the ordinance requires a park entry permit, but does not require that it be displayed.
