

FIRWOOD CPO MEETING MINUTES

Sept 7, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Marge Stewart at 7:00pm 22 neighbors present

I.. The meeting minutes from Aug 3 meeting were approved.

II. Land Use Application: Z0344-21 Forest Template Test to authorize the placement of a dwelling on the subjects property. This application is substantially similar to previously approved land use application Z0386-13-FTT which expired in 2017 The Location is south of US 26 approximately 920 ft. SW of intersection with Cherryville Drive. The applicant is Mark Ferrante.

III. Fall Road Clean-up Sue Hein has designated Oct 16-17 or Oct 23-24 Please respond to which date would work for you. Sept. 18 is the George Community Road clean up date.

IV. Kleinsmith Rd Property Update. The property owner has applied for building of a storage unit instead of caregiver residence. The County responded that they cannot process this due to unpaid taxes. Remaining options are to sell the property and remove or demolish the building. On Sept 10 there is planned an onsite inspection by Andrea Hall. Rick will pass on concerns about dog fighting activity.

V. Update on 442nd situation. Mr. Snyders stated that his son has been locked up for 3 months now and is still awaiting a court date. He is concerned about his care and mental evaluation. Rick confirmed that the CPO's letter had been sent to the assistant DA and there was acknowledgment that it had been received.

VI Dave Bugni from the Eagle Creek Watershed was present and shared information re: his work in gathering any geological and cultural history of the Eagle Creek drainage. If anyone has historical pictures please forward them to him for a community website. The contact site is on Facebook at EC Watershed.

VI. Update on Clackamas Fire District Wildfire Season Townhall Meeting at Redland Fire Station on Aug 9th,. Marge attended this meeting and stated that there was a noticeable improvement in agencies working together. It was the first time that the Sherriff's department has attended. Discussion among fire districts and sheriffs dept. of ways to coordinate response and information re: wildfire status. The coding system for notifying status for occupancy of homes during evacuation is being changed to all agencies being able to input and receive information at a common site.

VII. Fire/Disaster Preparedness and Emergency Resource list: The city of Sandy is working on a grant that may assist in a CERT Team training. Phil Schneider emphasized

the importance of community members being actively involved in expressing their needs. There is an agreement among neighboring fire districts to help each other on emergency responses. Plans for additional staff at outlining stations are on going.

VIII. Sue Hein displayed the new sign for the Firwood CPO Meetings It will be up for next months meeting.
