Officer Reports: The Treasury has a balance of \$1,320.32.

## Scott Hoelscher: Request/Update regarding the Roethe Road Crossing.

Mr. Hoelscher came to request a letter of support from the OGCC for a grant to improve crossings on Roethe Rd. After discussion that included talk of the need for a crossing on a side street near the High School, Wayne Potter moved that the community send a letter of support and Mark Elliot seconded the motion. It unanimously passed.

- Brad Albert: Operation Manager for Oak Lodge Water Services Authority. Mr. Albert gave some of his personal background and offered an overview of the OLWS activity including an agreement to mutually share water with Milwaukie in the case of emergencies, and a pending open house in February to speak of capital projects. Regular OLWS meetings occur on the 2nd Tuesday at 4 pm at the Maple Street building.
- Joseph Edge: LUART: Site plans for the Chick Fil A at Courtney and McLoughlin were shared; A new memory care facility is planned on Linden Lane south of Courtney. There was a short explanation of the new zoning codes for single family lots. More next month.
- Charitable Giving Discussion Jane Civiletti led a discussion about giving money from the OGCC funds to the community for charitable purposes. After discussion Anatta Blackmarr moved that the OGCC give \$200 to New Urban High School for their Christmas event, and \$100 to each of the three elementary schools in the area for Back-Pack Buddies. Bob Bohannon second the motion. The community decided unanimously to give the \$500 as designated.

**Committee Reports:** The New Library is coming along well. There will be a process and an opportunity to consider names for the Community Center.
