*Critical Repairs and Upgrades: Roofing, plumbing, HVAC, and electrical systems; building exteriors, site repairs and improvements.		
*Educational Enhancements: Improving facilities for Career and Technical programs, science lab updates, classroom technology improvements.		
*Recreation and Athletics: Athletic facilities and playground Improvements.		
*Other Projects: Cafeteria upgrades, modular removal, and furniture replacement.		
The bond aims to address aging infrastructure, improve safety, and enhance learning environments districtwide. Bonds may be issued in multiple series, each maturing within 21 years of issuance. Current bond levy rate to remain at estimated \$4.30/\$1,000 of assessed value;		
when existing bonds expire in 2027 bond levy rate will drop to an estimated \$3.99/\$1,000. Actual bond levy rates may differ depending an interest rates,		
changes in property value.
