- Appointment required
- Insurance accepted for exposure and symptomatic testing
- Out-of-pocket: \$139-\$199
- Molecular, rapid antigen, and antibody testing available

Legacy GoHealth

- Multiple locations
- Appointment preferred, walk-ins accepted
- Insurance accepted
- Out-of-pocket: \$75-\$99
- Molecular testing available

Providence Express/Immediate Care

- Multiple locations
- Appointment required
- Insurance accepted
- Out-of-pocket: \$95-\$125
- Molecular, rapid antigen, and antibody testing available

DO NOT go to a hospital emergency department if you only need to be tested for COVID-19. If you cannot access a test but are experiencing symptoms or have been exposed, follow isolation and quarantine guidelines.

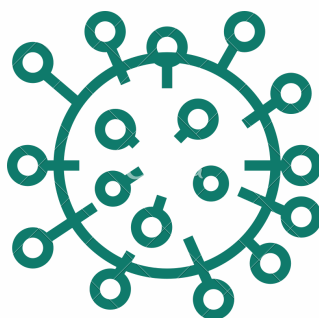
