

We're looking for a **Community Service Officer (CSO)** to provide public information and administrative support to uniformed personnel in the Sheriff's Office, Patrol Division.

The CSO is an unarmed, uniformed position that supports the Sheriff's Office by assisting the public and providing a variety of services which includes assisting sworn deputies with some of their more routine duties. This work is done in one of several secure Sheriff's facilities, and involves significant contact with the public to supply or gather information by telephone or in person, provide law enforcement related services, take police reports, and assist law enforcement personnel in administrative functions.

We're seeking individuals who enjoy working with the public and thrive in a fast-paced work environment. Competitive candidates will have strong administrative support/office skills, outstanding communication and customer-service skills, excellent multitasking abilities, proficiency with computers, and a desire to work in a law enforcement environment. Previous experience in a law enforcement agency is preferred.
