

Youth Substance Abuse Prevention Notice of Funding Opportunity FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Question 1:

How feasible is the consideration for funding our current position in prevention and our expansion into youth recovery work at closer to \$50,000 per year? Should each project apply separately, applying as one organization?

- Maximum grant award amount is \$50,000/year for three years.
- One organization may apply for more than one grant if the projects are distinct

Question 2:

Can you define what costs should be listed under Administrative costs

- Administrative expenses are costs incurred to support the functioning of an organization.

Question 3:

We want to check on our eligibility before we complete the application process

- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:
Eligible applicants are nonprofit organizations, schools, drug prevention coalitions or public entities serving residents of Clackamas County. Eligible projects must address the goals identified above and result in positive, measurable outcomes for Clackamas County residents.

It is expected that activities funded by YSAP are connected to the current mission of the applying agency and will enhance existing efforts of the applying agency.
