Since the gradual withdrawal of the Federal Secure Rural Schools program, the separation between static income from state road funding mechanisms such as gas tax and vehicle registration fees and expenses continues to widen each year.

The purpose of this session is to continue the discussion on local funding mechanisms that would generate additional revenue to fill the funding gaps projected for operations and paving maintenance. The critical funding gaps are:

- To maintain existing levels of service, with minimal roadway treatments and no capital
  paving projects, Clackamas County needs to fill an operational gap of \$5 million each
  fiscal year, adjusted for inflation.
- Rebuild the condition of county roads that have fallen below a rating of 60 and preserve
  the surface of existing roads with overlays on the local, collector, and arterial system
  would require an additional \$12.65 million annually. This level of funding would bring the
  county road system up to a pavement quality index of 60 (fair to good) over the course
  of a 21-year program.

With changing consumer patterns certain funding sources are more likely to sustain county programs into the future. At this planning session, staff will review five different funding sources from a lens of the long-term viability or special considerations that may apply to each as a local revenue source for road maintenance.
