STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

- 1. Prior to the Hearing. You have the right to make the following requests:
 - (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and to talk to County staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
 - (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
 - (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- 2. Procedure. The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence, the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that a violation exists, or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney to represent them at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question the parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- 3. Record of Proceedings. An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- 4. Hearings Officer. The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence, and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a Final Order or Continuing Order. The Hearings Officers Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon law. The Hearings Officer for Clackamas County is:

- 5. Right to Recess. If, during the course of the hearing, Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceeding be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- 6. <u>Right to Appeal</u>. The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

On or about the 28th day of April 2017 the Respondent violated the following laws, in the following ways:

a. Chapter 9.02 of the Clackamas County Code Building Code for failing to obtain permits and approved final inspections for the conversion of storage space to habitable space.

This violation is a Priority 1 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation

On or about the 28th day of June 2017 the Respondent violated the following laws, in the

following ways:

a. Chapter 9.02 of the Clackamas County Code Building Code for failing to obtain

permits and approved final inspections for the conversion of storage space to habitable space. This

violation is a Priority 1 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

On or about the 13th day of September 2021 the Respondent violated the following laws, in

the following ways:

a. Chapter 9.02 of the Clackamas County Code Building Code for failing to obtain

permits and approved final inspections for an accessory building on the property. This violation is a

Priority 1 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

b. Section 316.03 of the Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance for

the operation of a commercial business without land use approval. This violation is a Priority 2

violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

On or about the 7th day of February 2022 the Respondent violated the following laws, in

the following ways:

a. Chapter 9.02 of the Clackamas County Code Building Code for failing to obtain permits

and approved final inspections for an accessory building on the property. This violation is a Priority

1 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

Notice of the violation was given to Respondent in the following manner: Citation and Complaint 1600681, 1600681-2, 1600681-3 and 1600681-4. A copy of the notice document is attached to this Complaint as Exhibits C, D I, K, and incorporated by this reference.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter. Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

- 1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to immediately abate the violations and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining Respondent from violating these laws in the future;
- 2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty against Respondent for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County Commissioners. Said range for the Priority 1 violation being \$750.00 to \$1000.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code;
 - 3. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to pay an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County Code; and
 - 4. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties,

fines or fees that may be imposed:

5. Ordering any other relief deemed reasonably necessary to correct the violations.

STATEMENT OF PROOF Respondent.

History of Events and Exhibits:

November 8, 2016 In response to a complaint an alleged letter was sent to the Respondent Exhibit A

regarding the alleged conversion of a garage to habitable space on the subject

property.

November 16, 2016 As per a telephone conversation with the Respondent, he confirmed there is

living space above the garage but indicated that the living space was there when

he purchased the property. He uses the space for storage and a work space.

A violation notice was mailed to the Respondent with a deadline to submit a February 28, 2017 Exhibit B

building permit application to convert the area to accessory habitable space and

a guesthouse.

April 28, 2017 After a review of County records revealed that permits had not been issued to

> abate the violation, citation number 1600681 was issued to the Respondent in the amount of \$100.00. The citation was sent first class and certified mail and

was not returned to the County. This citation was paid on May 11, 2017.

June 28, 2017 After a review of County records revealed that permits had not been issued to

> abate the violation, citation number 1600681-2 was issued to the Respondent in the amount of \$500.00. The citation was sent first class and certified mail, the certified mail was returned to the County but the first class mail was not. This

citation was paid on July 19, 2017.

September 27, 2017 The County received an additional complaint alleging that there was an

unpermitted accessory building on the property. Google Earth photos showed

that the building appeared between 2011-2002.

April 5, 2018 Exhibit E	An email was sent to the Respondent to let him know that the building permits to convert the illegal living space back to storage had approved final inspections that that portion of the code enforcement case would be closed. What remained to be addressed was the unpermitted accessory building. The Respondent replied that he would find a designer to help him with plans and electrician to assist him.
October 10, 2018 Exhibit F	An email was sent to the Respondent to let him know an additional complaint had been received regarding an alleged auto repair business on the property without land use approval.
February 16, 2021 Exhibit G	A violation notice was sent to the Respondent with a deadline of March 19, 2021 to abate the violations.
March 31, 2021 Exhibit H	Respondent spoke to Code Enforcement Specialist Shane Potter and advised he had not received the February 16, 2021 violation notice and provided a PO Box for correspondence. An amended violation notice was sent to the PO Box with a deadline of May 3, 2021 to abate the violations.
September 15, 2021 Exhibit I	After a review of County and State records revealed that permits had not been issued for the accessory building and the business remained registered to the subject property, citation number 1600681-3 was issued to the Respondent in the amount of \$175.00. The citation was mailed first class mail and was not returned to the County, the citation remains unpaid.
September 21, 2021	In a telephone call with the Respondent, he indicated that he has ceased operating the auto repair business on the property but has kept his business name current because he does some contract work for dealerships, the work does not take place on his property. The County agreed to waive the \$75.00 violation fine. The Respondent further stated that he will contact the County to find out what he need to do to permit the accessory building.
February 9, 2022 Exhibit J	After a review of County records revealed that permits had not been issued for the accessory building on the property, citation number 1600681-3 was issued to the Respondent in the amount of \$500.00. The citation was sent first class mail and was not returned to the County. This citation remains unpaid.
March 23, 2023 Exhibit K	An amended citation was issued correcting the February 9, 2022 citation number from 1600681-3 to 1600681-4.

Enforcement Hearings Officer.

After a review of County records revealed that permits had not been issued for the accessory building, the matter was referred to the Clackamas County Code

March 27, 2023

If the Hearings Officer affirms the County's position that a violation of the Clackamas County Building Code exists on the subject property, the County would request a Continuing Order be issued requiring the Respondent to submit a permit application for the accessory building, technically complete plans and appropriate fees to the Clackamas County Building Codes Division within 45 days of the date of the Order. The Respondent must reply to all requests for additional information within ten days. An electrical permit for the structure should be obtained within ten days of the date the building permit is issued. An approved final inspection for both permits should be obtained within 30 days of the date the permits are issued.

Or, obtain an agricultural exemption for the structure within 30 days of the date of the Order and the electrical permit within ten days of the date the exemption is completed. An approved final inspection for the electrical permit should be obtained within 30 days of the date the permit is issued.

The County will submit a timely Post Hearing Status Report. The report will be sent to the Compliance Hearings Officer and to the Respondent. The report may include the following recommendations:

- o Payment of citation number 1600681-3 \$100.00
- o Payment of citation number 1600681-4 \$500.00
- o The imposition of civil penalties of up to \$1000.00 for each day cited September 13, 2021 and February 7, 2022.
- o The administrative compliance fee to be imposed from February 16, 2021 which is currently \$1875.00
- If the violations are not abated the County may request authorization for further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.
- The County requests the Hearing's Officer to permanently enjoin the Respondent from violating these laws in the future.

As you know, it has come to the attention of the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section that living space has been created above the garage on the above referenced property without land use approval or building permits. This constitutes a violation of Section 316 of the Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance and Chapter 9.02.040 of the Clackamas County Code as it pertains to the Application and Enforcement of the Clackamas County Building Code.

On January 24, 2017, a notice was mailed to you outlining a schedule for compliance. The deadline for permitting the habitable space or converting the area back to its permitted use was February 27, 2017.

On February 22, 2017, you met with Code Enforcement Specialist Dean Brown at the County. You indicated to Dean that you intend to contact a design professional to assist you with plans to convert the area to accessory habitable space and a quest house.

In order to abate the violations, please submit the building permit applications, technically complete plans and appropriate fees no later than April 3, 2017. The permit must be picked up within ten days of being notified. Please schedule all inspections so that final inspections may be obtained not later than 45 days of the date of the permit being issued.

Required Notice of Fines and Penalties

It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. Failure to resolve those violations may result in one or more of the following: (1) a citation and fine, (2) assessment of a \$75 per month administrative compliance fee, and (3) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.

The Clackamas County Code provides for fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties of up to \$3,500 for each day the County verifies the noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties may be assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.

Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may in its discretion waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.

Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered, the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Record.

Also, be advised that non-compliance with a Hearings Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel for legal action in Circuit Court which may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.

Finally, recurrences of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.
