EXPLANATORY STATEMENT - 500 words

About this Measure

If approved, this measure would amend Section 21A of the West Linn Charter. The change relates to the authority of a council member to provide input to the City Manager on certain topics without violating the Charter restriction on interference with administration. The proposed change to Section 21A of the Charter is underlined below:

Section 21A. No Interference with Personnel or Public Contracting

No City Council member may directly or indirectly, by suggestion, or otherwise, attempt to interfere, influence, or coerce the City Manager in the award of a public contract or <u>the hiring, discipline, or</u> <u>termination of</u> any personnel decision. This shall not prevent a City Council member from providing input to the City Manager relating to City business or the performance of an employee or department.

Why this Measure is Proposed

At a special meeting on July 24, 2017, the City Council devoted substantial time to considering and crafting proposed charter amendments to address the structure of legal services provided to City staff and the City Council. The City Council also addressed the issue of a council member's ability to give input to the City Manager about city business and the performance of city departments and staff. At the meeting, members of the City Council expressed that it is the role of the City Council to give input to the City Manager on city business issues, but council members were concerned that Section 21A of the Charter prohibited such input. The City Council prepared this proposed charter amendment to clarify the circumstances under which a council member could provide input to the City Manager.

Amendment of the Charter requires approval by the City's voters.

If This Measure is Approved

This amendment will clarify that members of the City Council may give input to the City Manager so long as their actions do not attempt to interfere, influence or coerce the City Manager in the award of a public contract or the hiring, discipline, or termination of any personnel. (333 words)
