Presentation Title: 172nd 190th Corridor Management Plan Update

POLICY QUESTION

The 172nd 190th Corridor Management Plan is in the last stage of the analysis of alternative road alignments for this regional transportation corridor. The Project expects to reach a consensus on a preferred alignment this summer. The study session is intended to provide the Board with background information on the work to date and the next steps in the process.

ISSUE & BACKGROUND

The 172nd 190th Corridor Management Plan was set up through an IGA between ODOT, Metro and the County in March 2010 and is funded by federal transportation planning funds. This project is intended to be a demonstration of one approach to merging the transportation planning and NEPA processes.

When the 172nd 190th Corridor Management Plan is completed, the County and the cities of Damascus, Happy Valley and Gresham will be asked to amend their existing Transportation System Plans (County Comprehensive Plan Chapter 5) to reflect the preferred alternative. Metro may also need to amend the Region Transportation Plan.

QUESTION(S) PRESENTED FOR CONSIDERATION

Staff is requesting Board initial comments on the three alignments prior to the next round of public input.
