Guest Speaker: Jeff Nitschke, Deputy DA with Clackamas County presented a power point presentation and led discussion on Marijuana, Traffic Laws, DUII- Impairment and Marijuana Laws.

-Triple Fatal on February 18th in Damascus. Single car crash with speed and alcohol as factor.
-Single fatality in Molalla on Vick road pedestrian fatality-

Safety Action Plan:

The board is in full support of the plan. There are many parts and pieces to the plan. There are a lot of culture components to help change the mindset for safe driving.

I205 Expansion: Michael Wilson presented an article on the I205 expansion which will include widening Abernathy Bridge. This is a high priority for ODOT due to a high traffic volume. This project is estimated to be \$450 million and is awaiting funding. A few overpasses and streets in West Linn will need to be revamped due to this new expansion.

Beavercreek Interchange Mobility: Last TSP update for the City of Oregon City determined that the intersection will no longer fit the mobility standard for 2035. The city has created a technical advisory committee to look into improving the intersection. Christian shared some drawings on idea being proposed for the intersection. The city is looking to upgrade the intersection and/or updating the mobility of the standards.

Rosemont Trail

There is no new status change: Columbia land trust to do easements, City of West Linn is splitting the costs and estimated completion Spring 2017.
