HIDTA Presentation on ODMAP - <i>Chris Gibson</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Chris presented on a system that is used by law enforcement and emergency responders to log and track drug overdoses. This data is used by many government agency's to track spikes of drugs in areas and helps taskforces to reduce trafficking and distribution of drugs in the nation. This system provides real-time information and location of these events. He showed the council how the application is used and the wide range of data it could provide without violating HIPAA information, as names are not used. Currently this data can take months or years to become available to task forces to help fight this drug pandemic. 	Invite Apryl H. from PH to talk about how the county uses this data.
