
COST UPDATE

Construction	\$4.6 million	\$6.7 million	\$2.1 million
Indirect/Soft Cost	\$2 million	\$2.3 million	\$.3 million
Master Planning	\$.35 million	\$.35 million	\$0
Total	\$7 million	\$9.4 million	\$2.4 million

- Clackamas County Board of Commissioners decision to delay construction up to one year at May 11, 2022 policy session
- Will provide new estimate based off of Construction Documents in 9 months. Staff will present this information to the BCC at subsequent meeting (date TBD)
- County also agreed to pick up the library portion of the project cost that was originally shown to be \$2.1M






