STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

- 1. Prior to the Hearing. You have the right to make the following requests:
 - (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and to talk to County staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
 - (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
 - (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- 2. Procedure. The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence, the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that a violation exists, or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney to represent them at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question the parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- 3. Record of Proceedings. An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- 4. Hearings Officer. The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence, and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a Final Order or Continuing Order. The Hearings Officers Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon law. - 5. Right to Recess. If, during the course of the hearing, Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceeding be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- 6. <u>Right to Appeal</u>. The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

I, Andrea Hall, Senior Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

Respondent Daniel Bogdan's mailing address is: 12444 SE Stark St., Portland, OR 97233.

2.

The address or location of the violation(s) of law alleged in this Complaint is: 19991 SE Foster Rd., Damascus, OR 97089, also known as T1S, R3E, Section 32C, Tax Lot 1703, and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon.

On or about the 5th day of May, 2022 the Respondent violated the following laws, in the following ways:

a. Chapter 9.02.040 of the Clackamas County as it pertains to the Application and Enforcement of the Clackamas County Building Code for failure to obtain an approved final inspection for a Major Repair permit for the septic system on site. This violation is a Priority 1 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

5.

Notice of the violation was given to Respondent in the following manner: Citation and Complaint number 1900002-2. A copy of the notice document is attached to this Complaint as Exhibit C, and incorporated by this reference.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter. Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

- 1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to immediately abate the violations and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining Respondent from violating these laws in the future;
- 2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty against Respondent for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County Commissioners. Said range for the Priority 1 violation being \$750.00 to \$3500.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code;
 - 3. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to pay an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County Code; and
 - Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties, fines or fees that may be imposed:

STATEMENT OF PROOF

History of Events and Exhibits:

January 3, 2019 Exhibit A	Information was forwarded to Code Enforcement from the County's Septic and Onsite Wastewater staff when the Respondent failed to comply with a violation notice regarding the septic system on the subject property.
January 3, 2019 Exhibit B	Citation 1900002 was issued in the amount of \$100.00 for failing to obtain an approved final inspection for a Major Repair permit for the septic system. The citation was sent first class mail and certified mail, neither mailing was returned to the County.
February 13, 2019	I spoke with the Respondent who indicated that he never received the 2018 violation notice from the County so I sent him a copy.
May 5, 2022 Exhibit C	After a review of the County's permit system revealed that a new permit for the septic system had not been submitted, citation 1900002-2 was issued in the amount of \$100.00. This citation was sent first class mail and was paid on May 23, 2022. Citation 1900002 dated January 2, 2019 was voided as the wrong code section was cited.
May 20, 2022 Exhibit D	An email was sent to the Code Enforcement mailbox and forwarded to me. The message was from Nidia Herrera Bogdan outlining challenges they are facing that are preventing them from abating the violation.
May 23, 2022 Exhibit E	I replied to Nidia with information I had received from Senior Soils Scientist Aaron Dennis indicating that there may be a way to work around the easement issue and the first step would be a site evaluation.
August 5, 2022	After a review of the County's permit system revealed that neither a new permit nor a site evaluation application had been submitted for the septic system had not been submitted, the matter was referred to the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.

If the Hearings Officer affirms the County's position by a preponderance of the evidence, the County would request a Continuing Order be issued requiring the Respondent submit an application for a new septic permit within 30 days of the date of the Order. The septic permit application should also include maintenance records for the last five years.

The County will submit a timely Post Hearing Status Report. The report will be sent to the Compliance Hearings Officer and to the Respondent. The report may include the following recommendations:

- o The imposition of civil penalties of up to \$3500.00 for date cited May 5, 2022.
- The administrative compliance fee to be imposed from February 2019 until the violation is abated, that amount is currently \$3225.00.
- If the violation is not abated the County may request authorization for further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.
- The County requests the Hearing's Officer to permanently enjoin the Respondent from violating these laws in the future.

We went through a long violation with Daniel Bogdan back in 2014 and 2015 that eventually landed with Code Enforcement before he applied for and was issued a permit under ST008716. That permit was never given final approval and the property owner never followed through with the required documents needed to give it final approval. In October I opened a new violation and wrote Mr. Bogdan requesting he pay for a new permit and submit the required documents and photos to get septic approval for his property at 19991 SE Foster Rd. He has once again chosen to not respond to our letters just as he did back in 2014 and 2015. So I am forwarding the file that includes both the current violation (SV0002918) and the past violation (SV0001114) in hopes that he can be encouraged to comply.

To whom it may concern:

Clackamas County Septic Onsite Wastewater staff have confirmed the sewage treatment system serving the above site is currently in violation of Oregon State Rule and Clackamas County Code.

Your septic permit ST008716 expired on March 30, 2017. Photos or Video of the ATT installation were not received as per Edgar Diaz's requirement on April 6, 2016, A copy of a recorded easement to the drainfield area and an inspection request to verify that drainfield was never received. In addition, we did not receive the required annual maintenance report for the year of 2017 as required for your Alternative Treatment Technology (ATT) system.

Insufficiently treated wastewater is a threat to public health. Improper wastewater management is a violation of Oregon Administrative Rule 340-071-130 and Clackamas County Code 9.01.100 (L)

340-071-0130

General Standards, Prohibitions and Requirements

(17) Annual permit fees and reports:

- (a) Owners of pressurized distribution, sand filter, recirculating gravel filter, and alternative treatment technology systems and those systems described in section (16)(d) of this rule not under WPCF permits must submit annual fees and reports as follows:
 - (A) Owners must pay the annual report evaluation fee in OAR 340-071-0140(3) by the date specified by DEQ for each year the system is in operation. A system is placed in operation when it first receives wastewater and remains in operation until DEQ receives notice the system has been decommissioned:
 - (B) Owners must submit written certification prepared by a maintenance provider on a DEQapproved form that:
 - (i) The system has been maintained in accordance with the requirements of the rulesin this division during the reporting year and is operating in accordance with the agent-approved design specifications

(6) A person may not connect to or use any system completed after January 1, 1974, unless a Certificate of Satisfactory Completion has been issued for the installation or deemed issued by operation of law in accordance with this rule.

For compliance, the following corrective actions are required:

A new Major Repair septic permit will be required as the ST008716 permit has been expired for over a year and cannot be renewed. Submittal of photos or video of the ATT unit installation, a copy of the recorded easement, a maintenance agreement and inspection report, and all final paperwork such as an As-Built and Installed Material List will then be required for final approval of the system. The new permit must be applied for by October 23rd, 2018 and all required paperwork, photos, and inspections completed by November 12th, 2018 to prevent this being escalated to code enforcement.

It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. Failure to resolve those violations may result in one of more of the following: (1) a citation and fine, (2) assessment of a \$75 per month administrative compliance fee, and (3) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement Hearings Officer for legal.

The Clackamas County Code provides for fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties of up to \$3500 for each day of noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties are assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.

Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.

Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered, the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Record.

Also, be advised that non-compliance with a Hearings Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel for legal action in Circuit Court and may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.

Finally, recurrences of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.

I checked with Senior Soils Scientist, Aaron Dennis, and he indicated that if the area previously denied has not seen any further grading and filling since 2003, it may be suitable under a "reasonable repair" for use. In order to determine if this area is usable, you will need to submit an application for a site evaluation to determine the suitability of the soil and area available for a property sized drain field.
