| How are MHAC initiatives being led with a Prevention Lens? - Teresa and Pam | Excerpt from Mary's presentation: <br> A. Universal intervention: Strategies and/or activities that engage the general public or a segment of the entire population to: learn and enhance positive coping methods to help people feel safe and hopeful and improve quality of life, reduce mental health symptoms, and increase awareness of mental health wellness services, and supports. <br> B. Selective intervention: Strategies and/or activities that serve specific sub populations whose risk of a disorder is significantly higher than the average, either imminently or over a lifetime. <br> C. Indicated intervention: Strategies and/or activities that address identified individuals who have minimal but detectable signs or symptom of a disorder or condition. <br> $>$ Actions from this group: this council has already sent out a survey to schools asking, "are you aware of resources available around you." <br> $>$ Possibly reaching out to NWFS to find out what prevention services mean to them, what they are doing, what resources are available to them. <br> > Exploring how to recognize students needing help. <br> > Gaining knowledge about the actions taken by other programs. | The council can send letter to OLCC making the case as to why adding public health member is needed. Communication plan is to promote from somebody with lived experience "have we had the recovery center in past, how would that have made a difference for you to not land in jail". Possibly looking for 3-5 volunteers who would be open to being interviewed. Sara and Bo volunteer. <br> Having an appraisal happening, board has directed that this will be property that will be purchased. Notice of funding opportunity for providers to apply possibly in July. <br> Update on BH Housing Investment: Transcending Hope having an open house on Friday May $31^{\text {st }}$ from 12-2pm. <br> No major updates on the 23-Hour Crisis Stabilization Center: Calling it Stabilization Center for now. Waiting to send out bidding for construction. Will go in front of the board at the end of July. Last legislative session was looking for shovel ready properties and Clackamas County was a recipient.
