Ballot Language: Annexation of Boring Area into CCFD#1

Explanatory Statement: (461 words)

This measure approves annexation of all territory (the "Area") currently within Boring Rural Fire Protection District #59 ("Boring Fire") into Clackamas County Fire District #1 ("CCFD#1"). This has been proposed by the elected bodies of both Boring Fire and CCFD#1 in an effort to promote integrated and consistent fire and emergency responder services to the Area. CCFD#1 has been providing these services pursuant to a contract since 2014. Boring Fire's board has publicly stated in applications and testimony to the Board of County Commissioners that its' current fire response model, which depends on volunteers, does not meet their expectations for fire response and believe that CCFD#1 can provide full-time, professional fire and emergency response services at a lower cost due to its existing infrastructure.

Boring Fire has adopted a plan of dissolution to transfer all assets and properties to CCFD#1 if approved by voters. This measure and the overall realignment of the Area is contingent upon the passage of two other measures. The first is the approval of the dissolution by voters of Boring Fire, Measure 3-493. The second is the approval of annexation of the area into CCFD#1 by CCFD#1 voters, Measure 3-494. The third is the approval of annexation of the area into CCFD#1 by voters of Boring Fire (this measure). All three measures must pass or all are considered null and void.

The Board of County Commissioners ("BCC") held a hearing on the proposal on July 28th, and found that both Boring Fire and CCFD#1 had met the statutory criteria necessary to advance this question to voters. Therefore the BCC has ordered an election be held on this measure and the two related measure as described above. If passed, the annexation will be effective only after the plan of dissolution is completed. Current Boring Fire residents would then pay the CCFD#1 permanent ad valorum rate of \$2.4012 plus an assessment for an outstanding general obligation bond, currently a collective total of \$2.4951 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Such residents would cease to pay the Boring Fire permanent tax rate of \$2.3771 per \$1,000 of assessed value as of that same effective date.

CCFD#1 is one of the largest fire protection district in Oregon, serving approximately 220,000 citizens within the cities of Happy Valley, Johnson City, Milwaukie, Oregon City, and the unincorporated areas of Carver, Beavercreek, Carus, Center Point, Clarkes, Damascus, Oak Lodge, Redland, South end, Sunnyside and Westwood. The district provides a wide range of services including fire suppression, advanced life support, emergency medical care, fire prevention swift water rescue, hazardous materials response, Community Emergency Response Teams, emergency management, community education and other programs. The district responds to the communities needs from twenty strategically located community fire stations with a workforce of approximately 256 employees and 100 volunteers.
