

Rules & Information

- 1) Registration is from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. Judging begins at 9 a.m. Entries not in their assigned place by 9 a.m. may not be judged. The parade begins promptly at 10 a.m. Registration is free.
- 2) Kiwanis must receive a signed waiver from the adult responsible for each entrant. Groups with more than one child may list them on the back of the form, but must provide waiver signatures for each child.
- 3) Participants ribbons must be worn by all child participants. Kiwanis provides the ribbons during registration. Each participating child and accompanying adult will also receive a ticket for free admission to the fair, good on the day of the parade only, UNTIL WE RUN OUT.
- 4) Animals must be on leash, harness, or halter with reins. Parade entrant must clean up any waste material.
- 5) No go-karts, motorbikes, mini-motorbikes, or lawn mowers.
- 6) **HELMETS ARE REQUIRED** when riding bikes, trikes, rollerblades, skateboards, scooters, unicycles, etc.
- 7) **<u>DO NOT THROW CANDY.</u>** Participants may <u>hand out</u> candy along the sides of the parade route but may not direct candy where children might run in front of the line of march. <u>"SAFETY FIRST."</u>
- 8) **NO CAMPAIGNING.** Current officeholders may participate as representatives of their governmental office, but may not display campaign materials, literature, or handouts.
