Additional funding (\$391,000) will be coming from Care Oregon and is not accounted for in the budget document. This new funding will be dedicated to the new Sandy Dental clinic.	
		Productivity is edging up. Primary Care has held steady at about 90% and Behavioral Health and Dental have been increasing 1-2% monthly.
