#### WHAT ACTION ARE YOU REQUESTING FROM THE BOARD?

Staff requests approval of the 2016 Small Grants Recommendation

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The Clackamas County Board of Commissioners approved \$250,000 in the 2016/17 FY budget to fund the 2016 Small Grants Program. This is the eighth year of the program. The goal is to support agencies that are making an effort to develop and implement innovative projects that would help most vulnerable families, seniors, and others meet their basic needs such as food assistance and abuse prevention. Preference is given to those who meet the following criteria:

- Prevent occurrence of larger, more dire problems later;
- Save money later through early intervention;
- Serve people throughout the community.

For the 2016 cycle, Administration staff, along with Public and Government Affairs and Technology Services worked diligently to increase awareness and ease of use of our website and application process. A Press Release went out, the Small Grants web page was featured on the main County webpage, and an email notice was sent out to all past applicants. The online application process was streamlined to ensure applications were received and acknowledged in a timely manner.

We received 69 applications for a total request of \$711,084.60. This is a decrease in applications from 90 applications received last year and a decrease in the amount requested which totaled \$725,096.40. A committee was formed to review the applications as well as past small grant awards and current funding from other county departments to determine the attached recommendations (attachment 1). The committee included Caroline Hill, Small Grants Coordinator; Kimberlee DeSantis, Commissioner Policy Coordinator; Jennifer Joslin-Brown, Department of Employee Services and Kimberly Wollenburg, Water Environment Services.

Information was distributed to committee members in August for review prior to two subsequent meetings on August 31 and September 14. The committee has remained in contact via email to complete the attached recommendation (see attachment 1). Our focus was to ensure that the monies were dispersed as evenly as possible throughout the County and to impact diverse groups.

Today we are seeking approval of the recommendation (see attachment 1) from the Board so that we can process awards.
