

## OSU Extension's Mission, Vision, Core Values, Services



#### Extension Service Structure (OSU Employees)






# Key Performance Measures & Results aka...what you get for the money

- → \$2.348 million Extension District tax revenue for FY18-19...
- State/OSU faculty Support (county and state) → ~\$4 million/year.
- Grants/Contracts generated by local faculty  $\rightarrow$  ~\$1.5 million/year.
- Volunteers In Kind Service value → ~\$1.5 million/year.
- Served nearly 100,000 citizens with informal education/outreach.
- Delivered about 500 educational events reaching 50,000 citizens.
- Trained and supported approximately 1,600 Extension volunteers who contributed about 80,000 hours of service to the community.

### Emerging Issues...and opportunities

- Growing population in Clackamas County, demands and opportunities for education programs and services.
- New Extension Education Center will provide capacity to better serve the community with room for growing faculty, staff, and volunteers plus improved facilities for learning.
- Successful private fundraising effort for Education Center will allow Extension Service District financial resources to be devoted entirely to programs and services instead of debt service. Fundraising effort will create culture of philanthropy leading to greater opportunities in future.
