ORS 248.015 Precinct committeepersons; qualifications; election; vote required; term. (1)

A precinct committeeperson shall be a representative of the major political party in the precinct. At the primary election a major political party shall elect from its members **a precinct committeeperson for every 250 electors, or major fraction thereof**, who are registered in the precinct 251 days before the primary election. In any event the political party members of a precinct shall be entitled to elect **not less than two** committeepersons in the precinct. A person may not hold office as precinct committeeperson in more than one precinct.
