Housing Needs Assessment Update	County staff presented an update on the countywide Housing Needs Assessment, showcasing several findings from various cities, and discussing some of the tools that agencies might use to begin addressing housing issues. More will be addressed at the June 14/15 C4 Retreat.
STIP 100% List	Jon Makler from ODOT presented on the 2021-2024 STIP program, showcasing the 100% list and how projects fit into each category.

Retreat Agenda Discussion	County staff shared a retreat agenda blueprint, and noted the upcoming registration period. C4 wished to hold open a few sessions to address any business that comes up between May and June, or legislative issues that need urgent attention.
