Thank you for advising the Clackamas County Refuse and Recycling Association (CCRRA) that one of the industry positions on the Clackamas County Solid Waste Commission (SWC) is open and per the SWC bylaws CCRRA needs to forward two nominations for a member to fill that vacancy. Cory Hansen previously held that position and since he no longer works for Kahut's Services, Cory is not eligible for membership on the SWC.
