EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: This amendment updates the grant amount to include additional funds for award SCP-23-03. The purpose of this grant revenue is to improve the legitimacy, efficiency, and effectiveness of the state and local criminal justice system. Health Centers Division has been a recipient of this biennial funding for multiple cycles. This renewal of funding continues the financial investment into the existing Clackamas County Mental Health Treatment program and will help fund treatment, housing, and other supportive services to participants.

SCP-23-03 GRANT AGREEMENT

AMENDMENT #01

CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION SPECIALTY COURT GRANT PROGRAM

This is Amendment No. 1 to Grant Agreement No. SCP-23-03 ("Agreement") between the State of Oregon, acting through its Criminal Justice Commission ("CJC" or "State"), and **Clackamas Mental Health Court** ("Recipient").

- 1. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Agreement shall become effective on the date that it is fully executed and approved as required by applicable law.
- 2. <u>Amendment to Agreement</u>. The Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

A. The Grant Amount in Section 1 is amended and restated as follows:

Grant Amount: \$625,285.00

- B. Section 3.A is amended and restated to include additional disbursements as follows:
 - A. <u>Disbursement</u>. Upon execution of this Agreement and satisfaction of all conditions precedent, CJC shall disburse initial Grant funds to Recipient in installments as listed:
 - (1) \$44,070.00 on September 5, 2023;
 - (2) \$44,070.00 on March 5, 2024;
 - (3) \$268,572.50 by July 30, 2024; and
 - (4) \$268,572.50 on March 5, 2025.
- 3. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Amendment may be executed in two or more counterparts (by facsimile or otherwise) each of which is an original and all of which when taken together are deemed one agreement binding on all Parties, notwithstanding that all Parties are not signatories to the same counterpart.
- 4. <u>Original Agreement</u>. Except as expressly amended above, all other terms and conditions of original Agreement remain in full force and effect. By its execution of this Amendment, Grantee certifies to CJC that the representations, warranties and certifications contained in the original Agreement are true and correct as of the effective date of this Amendment and with the same effect as though made at the time of this Amendment.

Recipient, by its signature below, acknowledges that it has read this Agreement, understands it, and agrees to be bound by its terms and conditions.
