## **SNAP – Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (Food Stamps)**

A program to help with food costs by using an Oregon Trail Card at the grocery store for people who are low income.

<b><u>Symbol</u></b>	<b><u>What is it called?</u></b>	<b><u>What will they give me?</u></b>
●	<b>Emergency Food Services</b>	Food Pantries and Food Boxes. Lines often start early. Bring a bag. Some programs require pre-registration.
◆	<b>Free Food Markets</b>	Food support including fresh produce in partnership with the Oregon Food Bank (used to be called community basket and harvest share). Bring a bag.
■	<b>Congregate Meal Sites</b>	Hot meals, usually lunch, for adults 60 and over on a donation basis. For those who are disabled and under 60, meal costs vary by site.
□	<b>Home Delivered Meals</b>	Delivers meals to adults 60 and over on a donation basis. For those who are disabled and under 60, meal costs vary by site.
❖	<b>Community Meals</b>	Hot meals to all members of the community. It does not matter what age you are.
*	<b>Community Garden</b>	Pieces of land where you can grow your own produce. Some ask you to volunteer and some charge a small yearly fee. SNAP can be used to buy seeds and plant starts to grow food. Some gardens have a waiting list.
+	<b>Farmers Market</b>	Farmers sell fruits and vegetables directly to you. Many are open only during the growing season.
+SNAP	<b>Farmers Market accepting SNAP benefits.</b>	Most markets swipe the Oregon Trail card at the information booth for tokens that can be used in the market. Some markets have SNAP MATCH which gives additional tokens to use at the market when an Oregon Trail card is used.
