A Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be conducted on May 25, 2017 at 11:00 AM. Bidders shall meet with District representatives at the Project Site located at 11436 SE Capps Road, Clackamas OR 97015 for that purpose. Attendance will be documented through a sign-in sheet prepared by the District representative. Prime bidders who arrive more than ten (10) minutes after the start time of the meeting (as stated in the solicitation and by the District's watch) or after the discussion portion of the meeting (whichever comes first) shall not be permitted to sign in and will not be permitted to submit a bid on the project.

Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud at the above Delivery address after the Bid Closing. Bid results will also be posted to the Clackamas County Procurement Website shortly after the opening.

To be eligible for award under this Invitation to Bid, the contractors team must meet minimum qualifications of prior examples of work, as detailed in the Clackamas County Water Environment Special Provision section 00201, within the following four (4) major project components: (1) Installation of buried gravity storm piping with a diameter of 24 inches or greater; (2) Construction of in-stream log structures in conformance with SLOPES V Restoration or comparable environmental protection regulations; (3) Soil management that requires characterizations, segregations, and salvage of native on-site soils; and (4) Large scale restoration and revegetation to create wetland and upland habitats.

State PWR

Prevailing Wage Rates requirements apply to this Project because the maximum compensation for all Owner-contracted Work is more than \$50,000. Contractor and all subcontractors shall comply with the provisions of ORS 279C.800 through 279C.870, relative to Prevailing Wage Rates. The Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) wage rates and requirements set forth in the following BOLI booklet (and any listed amendments to that booklet), which are incorporated herein by reference, apply to the Work authorized under this Agreement:
