Her father is a gunsmith, her husband is a combat Veteran, her brother-in-law works in law enforcement (NYPD), and Donna-Marie enjoys recreational shooting. Donna-Marie is also a survivor of a youth suicide attempt, which provides her with first-hand knowledge of the pain that brings a person to want to end their life, and that the right support can save lives.
