MEASURE EXPLANATORY STATEMENT FOR COUNTY VOTERS' PAMPHLET

The Charter currently provides that the Mayor will appoint the members of all city committees, which includes the Planning Commission and the Historic Review Board. This measure would amend the City Charter so that members of the Planning Commission and Historic Review Board shall be selected by a majority vote of the City Commission. The membership of all other city committees, other than the Planning Commission and Historic Review Board, shall continue to be accomplished by the Mayor.

If the measure is approved, Section 20 of the Charter would be amended to include the underlined language below:

Section 20 - Mayor.

The Mayor shall appoint the committees provided by the rules of the Commission. except the Planning Commission and the Historic Review Board, which shall be appointed by a majority vote of the Commission. He shall sign all records of proceedings approved by the Commission. He shall have no veto power and shall sign all ordinances passed by the Commission within three days after their passage. After the Commission approves a bond of a city officer or a bond for a license, contract, or proposal, the Mayor shall endorse the bond.

The result of a yes vote would be that the Mayor would continue to appoint most members of city committees, except that the members of the Planning Commission and Historic Review Board would be appointed by a majority vote of the Commission. A no vote would be that the Mayor would appoint the members of all city committees, including the members of the Planning Commission and Historic Review Board.
