**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**: The Social Services Division of the Health, Housing and Human Services Department requests approval of an Amendment to a Subrecipient Agreement with the Senior Citizens Council of Clackamas County to provide Older American Act (OAA) funded services for persons living in Clackamas County. Additional grant funds are provided to support critical services for individuals with disabilities who are not eligible for OAA-funded services. These services help older and disabled individuals to remain independent in the community while protecting their financial well-being.

The Senior Citizens Council provides support for at-risk seniors and adults with disabilities who are in danger of abuse, neglect, and exploitation. Services include guardianship, conservatorship, and diversion. Clients are often initially isolated with no one else to care for them and are referred to the Senior Citizens Council by social services agencies, police departments, and the court system.

These low-cost interventions often avoid costly interventions such as adjudication. The Senior Citizens Council services preserve client dignity, promote independence to every extent possible, and enhance the quality of their clients' lives.

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**RECOMMENDATION:** The staff respectfully requests that the Board of County Commissioners approve this amendment to the agreement (11259) and authorize Chair Smith to sign on behalf of Clackamas County.

#### Justification for Amendment:

Amendment #1 to Subrecipient Agreement 24-013 ("Agreement") with the Senior Citizens Council of Clackamas County Inc. ("SUBRECIPIENT") includes budget adjustments for ongoing delivery of services for fiscal year 2025 and results in an increase to the budget by an additional \$179,550, for a total Agreement amount of \$350,550.

This Amendment #1 is effective upon signature and continues through June 30, 2027.

Except as amended hereby, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect. COUNTY has identified the changes with *"bold/italic"* font for easy reference.

#### AMEND the following portions of Section 4, Grant Funds:

- 4. Grant Funds. COUNTY's funding for this Agreement is a combination of Federal, State and Local dollars as specified below by title and Assistance Listing Number ("ALN") number as appropriate. The maximum, not to exceed, grant amount COUNTY will pay for one year is \$171,000. Payments will be made on a unit-of-service basis, the award is conditional upon compliance with the terms herein and disbursements will be made in accordance with the schedule and requirements contained in Exhibit D: Reimbursement Request. Failure to comply with the terms of this Agreement may result in withholding of payment.
  - 1.1. Grant Funds: COUNTY's funding of **\$71,035** funds for this Agreement is the Older Americans Act (ALN: 93.044) issued to COUNTY by the State of Oregon, Department of Human Services ("ODHS"), Adults and People with Disabilities ("APD"), Community Services & Solutions Unit ("CSSU").
  - 1.2. Other Funds: COUNTY's funding of **\$99,965** for guardianship, conservatorship, and guardianship outlined in this Agreement are County General Funds as awarded by the Board of County Commissioners.
