| MH & n Drug Court Presentation | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Jennifer Rees gave a presentation on the Clackamas County Mental Health and Drug Court programs. The programs serve adults and collaborate with the Courts and Community Corrections. The programs help divert people from incarceration. MH Court serve those with SPMI and/or untreated BH conditions. ➤ Screenings are done by defense attorney, DA and probation office. ➤ Each court has its own team consisting of a Judge, DA Persecution and Probation Officer. | |

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| <p>Director's Update - Mary Rumbaugh</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Mary advised that the County currently have a 4 million dollar deficit. H3S made a case as a department that we could do a 1.2 million dollar reduction spread between multiple divisions rather than a set percentage per division. Out division took a 15% cut. The two programs within our division that use county general funds are our Crisis team and Admin. We cut a vacancy to meet this reduction requirement. ➤ She advised that the budget committee focused on the Metro bond and that the budget was passed as is. The Sherriff's department only had to cut 2 million dollars. ➤ Revenue will decrease as of 7/1/2020. Budget adjustments will be made based on the reduction of revenue. ➤ She is hopeful that the impact on our funding from the state is not as bad as she thought. She states the bigger concern is in the 21-23 FY. ➤ She advised that 25 million dollars was approved for BH supports in an emergency meeting at the state. ➤ Mary talked about the Cahoots program in Eugene. Advised they are working on what the Mobile Crisis unit will look like. | |
