TO BE PLACED ON 18" X 24" POLYESTER FILM W/STANDARD LAYOUT

The purpose of this form is to outline an optional method of supplying information to the public when there is a change in condition of a monument, but a Record of Survey Map is not required to be filed. This form should be filled out as completely as possible. If no new monument or accessories are set, please state that in the appropriate location.

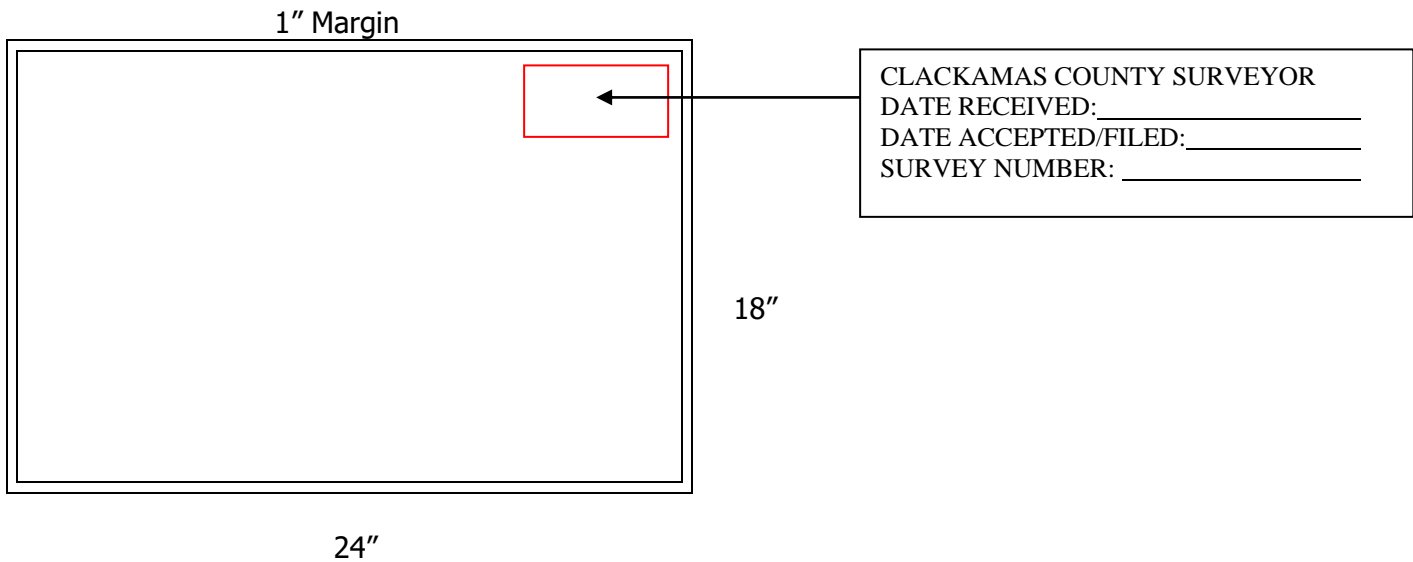
The *original* document must be filed at the Office of the County Surveyor. **DO NOT EMAIL** completed form to the County Surveyor's Office. Please copy form into AutoCAD, make your additions and plot on archival mylar with archival ink. There is no charge to file this report with the Clackamas County Surveyor.

The following information is required:

- Section, township, range
- Previous restorations/surveys
- Monument and accessories found
- Monument detail and sketch
- Monument or references set
- Basis of bearings
- Firm name/address/phone number
- Seal and signature
- More than one corner may be reported on the same sheet

***NOTE:** These instructions supersede any of the previous instructions.
