You have one job behind the wheel!

Any task beyond driving is a distraction that puts yourself and others at risk

Distracted drivers pose a deadly risk to everyone on the road. Drivers engage in a range of distracting activities from eating, grooming and reading to talking or texting on their phones. Hands-free is not risk-free, as there are mental distractions even when drivers keep their hands on the wheel and eyes on the road.

Distracted driver-related crashes occur every 2.5 hours in Oregon
Oregon's distracted driving law was strengthened in January 2018

It is now illegal to drive in Oregon while holding or **using any electronic device** such as phones, tablets, laptops and GPS systems. Drivers could be fined \$260 (maximum \$2,000) for the first conviction.
