 qualify as lateral experience.
- Oregon Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) maintains authority to determine acceptable lateral transfer of out of state certification to Oregon.

Candidates must successfully:

- Pass REACT exam (unless currently DPSST-certified or possessing a Bachelor's degree or higher)
- Pass a comprehensive background investigation, fingerprinting, post-offer pre-employment drug test, and physical and psychological exams
