## Ceder Property

### English Walnut

This English Walnut tree is located off of South Highland Road in rural unincorporated Clackamas County, east of Highway 213 and the Clackamas River. The house located on the property was built in 1915, and it is assumed that the English Walnut tree was planted in early 1920 by the residents.

This tree species is typically 40 to 60 feet tall with a rounded crown that can spread to 40 to 60 feet. The species prefers deep, dry, light loamy soils as opposed to wet or poor subsoil. The species may self-pollinate and people are recommended to plant two trees to ensure pollination.

This particular specimen reaches nearly the maximum height and exceeds the typical canopy span. It is a well-balanced and portioned specimen that is still productive.
